WORKSHOP TO FINALIZE THE COMMUNICATION PLAN AND DRAFT THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

28 Feb - 2 March 2022

This three-day residential workshop was to discuss and include the updated communication plan into the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) and to design the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that will set the tone for work at the Community Information Centers (CICs) between the stakeholders. It was also used as an opportunity to make inputs on the infographics designed to better communicate disaster information at the various centers.



28 February: Inputs on the infographic

Inputs were made by the stakeholders on the infographics in order for it to better communicate disaster information in simple clear language.

1 March: Drafting of Memorandum of Understanding

On this day, the participants designed and drafted the MOU between the stakeholders that will eventually help to better manage and run the CICs.

2 March: Communication plan discussion with consultants

Only one out of the three consultants was able to come for the workshop. The consultants said they had not yet finished developing the EMP and so would incorporate the communication plan into it when they finish. It was also an opportunity to go through the communication plan.

The videographers also used the opportunity to interview some of the stakeholders present on the work that has been going on the project so far.
